Created Creciendo Juntos (Growing Together) has been working with the Guancastecan districts to increase access to education and training, empowering residents of the region to achieve a sustainable future and better quality of life, under the convicthat local communities should play an important role in their own development. plies, sport supplies or any others; or you can adopt a family and share some time with them (have them to do some shopping groceries, clothes-school supplies, etc.).
